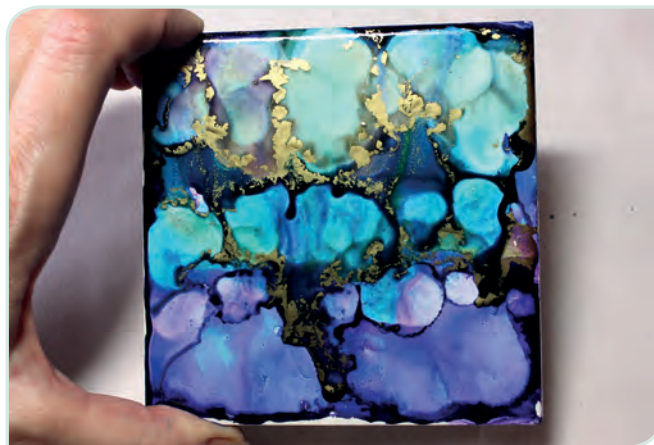




2 Manipulate the inks by tilting the tile and guiding the inks with a coffee stirrer.



3 Add a line of Piñata Gold to the top of the tile, followed by a line of alcohol. The alcohol will push the gold into the other inks.



4 If desired, use markers or a fine brush to add details. Or use a brush or cotton swab dipped in rubbing alcohol to create lighter areas.



5 Seal the finished tile with spray varnish. Quickly spray a light coat across the tile to avoid moving the inks. When the varnish is dry, apply another coat.
