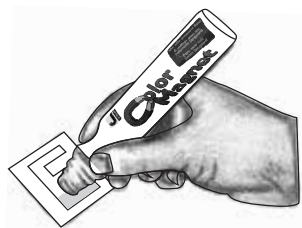


Instructions

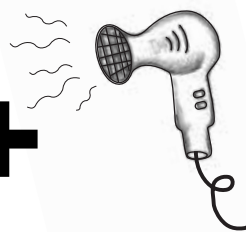
STEP 1



Insert paper between layers of garment.



Stencil with Color Magnet™ pen.

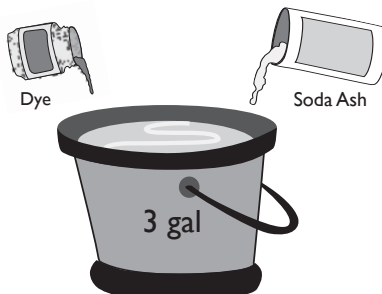


Dry thoroughly, letting dry overnight or using a hair dryer.



Go to Step 2 or Option A.

STEP 2

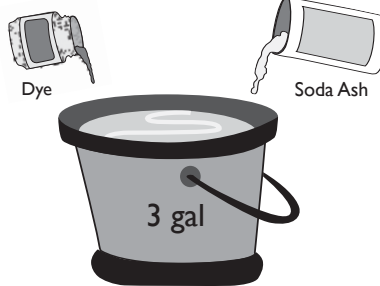
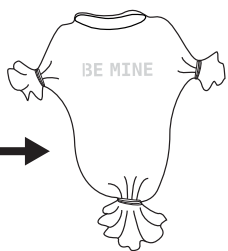


While wearing gloves, add soda ash and 1/2 jar of dye into bucket of warm tap water. Stir until dissolved and add garment(s). (See detailed Dyeing Instructions on other side)



For additional color with tie dye effects, go to Option B.

OPTION A (1 color garment)

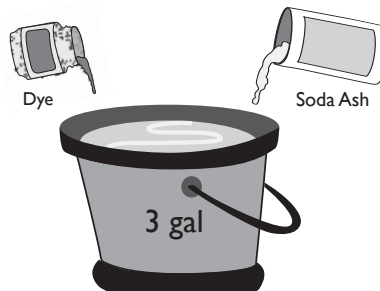
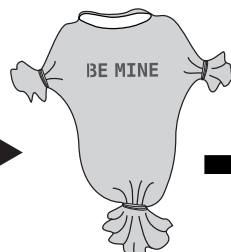


While wearing gloves, add soda ash and 1/2 jar of dye into bucket of warm tap water. Stir until dissolved and add garment(s). (See detailed Dyeing Instructions on other side)



Tie garment with rubber bands.

OPTION B (2 color garment)



While wearing gloves, add soda ash and 1/2 jar of dye into bucket of warm tap water. Stir until dissolved and add garment(s). (See detailed Dyeing Instructions on other side)



Tie garment with rubber bands.

DYEING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Fill bucket with 3 gallons warm to hot of tap water.
- 2 Put on gloves.
- 3 Add 1/2 jar of dye and 1 bag of soda ash to bucket of water.
- 4 Stir until dye and soda ash are dissolved.
- 5 Add garment(s) and stir. (3-5 lbs. of fabric per 1 jar of dye.)
- 6 Soak garments in bucket until desired color is achieved.
- 7 While wearing gloves, rinse garment(s) and wash with a mild detergent.

WASHING

- For best results, prewash garments.

COLOR MAGNET™ PEN

- Gently squeeze Color Magnet™ pen to apply medium. Do not OVER apply, or the medium will bleed under the stencil.
- The Color Magnet™ medium is tinted yellow so it can be seen while being applied. The yellow color will not affect dyeing.

TYING

- Get creative with tying techniques!
- The tighter the rubber bands, the more dramatic the contrast.
- For additional color effects follow Option B after completing Option A.

STENCILING

- Place a barrier (paper, wax paper, freezer paper, etc.) between layers of the garment before applying Color Magnet™, to avoid bleed through.
- Be careful not to tear the stencils so they can be reused.
- Use other stencils (not in the kit) or draw freehand illustrations with Color Magnet™.

GET MORE OUT OF THE STENCILS:

- For "<" or ">", use the "V" sideways
- For quotation marks, use the comma (x2)
- For a zero, use the letter "O"
- For a period, use the dot from the "!" or "?"
- The "~" can be used as an eñe or dash
- For "=", use "H" without the middle line
- Use masking tape to alter stencils or create your own
